Regional Public Hearings on the
Governor's Proposed 2026-2028 Biennial Budget

Overview of the Hearings

- **Date of Hearings:** Wednesday, January 7, 2026
- **Type of Hearings:** All hearings will be conducted in a virtual online format.
- **Number of Hearings:** Four Virtual Hearings by Region of the State:
Northern Virginia Western Virginia Hampton Roads Central Virginia (Richmond)
- **Hearings Start Time:** All hearings will begin at 10:00 AM.
- **Hearings End Time:** After all registered speakers have been heard or no later than 4:00 PM.

Registering to Speak at the Hearings

- **Registration Period:** The public may sign up to speak for one of the virtual public hearings on Tuesday, January 6, 2026, beginning at 8:00 AM through 4:00 PM.
 - Please check the House Appropriations or Senate Finance and Appropriations Committee websites for the latest information on registration closer to the registration date.

 - You may only register for one of the hearings.
 - After you register online, you will receive an email with a link for you to access the virtual meeting prior to the 10:00 AM start time on Wednesday, January 7, 2026. Please check the House Appropriations or Senate Finance and Appropriations Committee websites prior to the hearing start time to see the order of the public speakers and an estimated time range for when you will likely be called to speak.
 - Members of the General Assembly will participate in the hearing for the Region they represent so members of the public may choose the appropriate hearing for where they live. If the hearing where you live is full, you may sign up for a different location.

- It is possible that due to the number of signups, registration may reach full capacity, however, you may still submit public comments online or send them by mail (see details below).
- **Please note** that if you are signing up for someone else to speak that you must use a unique email for each registration. If you use the same email address, it will replace the previous registration.
